RULES OF ENTRY

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

ELIGIBLE ARTWORK:

- All work must be original and created without the supervision of an instructor. There is no limit on the age of the artwork. No nude figures or political subject matter is allowed.
- **Accepted media: oil, collage, watercolor, acrylic, mixed media, drawings, original prints, (no reprints unless reworked by hand). No 3D or assemblage works.**
- **Artwork must be presented in a professional manner, ready to hang with screw eyes and wire attached securely for hanging. No Saw tooth hangers.** Wiring must be in good condition and substantial enough for the weight of the artwork. Artwork may not exceed 30 lbs.
- All framed work must be under Plexiglas only. Frames and mats (white or neutral color only) must be museum quality and in good condition. Unframed canvases must have finished sides with no exposed staples.
- Space can accommodate large pieces. Size restriction is max 5' H x 5' W.

LIABILITY:

Artworks will be handled with care. Neither Women Painters West, Douglas Emmett Property Management, Encino Terrace Center, nor its officers, directors, employees, agents or volunteers are responsible for loss, theft, breakage or damage to any artwork, and the above reserve the right to reproduce accepted artwork for publicity and documentary purposes.

SALES:

All works must be offered for sale. Encino Terrace takes no commission. WPW requests a 20% donation from all sales.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

- Submit photos of up to five (5) artworks.
- Submit in a labeled 2-pocket folder:
 1. **Color photo** of each entry either printed directly or mounted on 8.5" X 11" letter size paper, one image per sheet. Label each entry: your name, title, date, medium, size and price. **No information on the photo face. Photos will not be returned to you.**
 2. **Artist Bio: Max 300 words, one page, brief personal history, artistic background, exhibitions, awards, education, collections, publications.**
 3. **Artist Statement: Max 300 words, one page, any descriptive information about your work: your materials, your process, your inspiration, etc.**
- **Entries must be received by WPW on or before Feb. 15th by 5 pm. We will accept envelopes at the WPW meetings January 14 and Feb 11, 2016.**

FEES:

\$30 for one to five entries. Make check payable to Women Painters West. All fees are non-refundable.

HAND DELIVERY:

Accepted artwork must be hand delivered on Saturday, April 23, 2016, 9 am to 10 am.
