## **President's Letter**



Hello Fellow Artists!

Welcome to 2023!! New Beginnings give us the opportunity to assess where we've been and where we want to go. What should we keep? What should we adjust? What should we put away, either for a bit or forever? New beginnings can be scary. There are so many "what ifs?" I find one way to assess is to sit and write down what you did and did not do to meet your goals and plans for the year? What worked and why? What didn't work and why?

When I was head of another art group, at the beginning of each year I sent out a self-assessment set of questions called the Two Step Business Plan. Most of us found it very helpful. What was most surprising about this set of questions was when I looked back at them the next year, I had accomplished SO much more that I thought and many of my goals were achieved. I'm enclosing it here for you. Take your time when you go through this. It isn't a one and done, and though it's coming to you in January, maybe February would be a better time for you to do this exercise. Or even March. Here it is:

#### Two - Step Business Plan for 2023

What were your accomplishments in 2022? Which one makes you feel most satisfied and fulfilled?

What was your plan for 2022? What parts of it got implemented and which parts got overlooked?

What customer/collector in 2022 contributed the most to your gross profit and which contributed most to your net profit?

What unexpected activities affected your business in a positive way and negative way?

What activities or people drained your time or energy without producing the results you desired?

What time did you spend on business functions (the daily, weekly and monthly tasks of administrations, bookkeeping, research, managing employees or freelancers, marketing, social networking, PR, etc.) and how much was spent on sales and creating new art designs or collections? What was your bottom line in 2022 compared to 2021, and your plan for 2023?

#### **Business Plan**

What from 2022 do you want to keep, eliminate, or change based on your year-end results?

What trends do you expect for 2023 (increase income, more retail exposure, broader brand awareness, etc.)?

Who are your competitors and what can you do, and are willing to do to distinguish yourself from them?

How do you want to expand in 2023 (sales, profits, employees, art, target audiences)?
