Alaïa Parhizi was born in Zurich, Switzerland. Early on, he challenged traditional schooling and the norms of education. He became a self-taught artist in drawing, painting, and eventually in music.

Initially, he released instrumental experimental music beginning in February 2013 under the name of Olïa and released his first Vocal album in December 2018 under his own name. His first time exhibiting his paintings was in a group exhibition with Matthew Jackson in Oakland, California.

In April 2018, Parhizi opened Wonzimer, a Los Angeles-based gallery space. Since its inception, the gallery has been a creative hub that has exhibited many important contemporary artists.

Parhizi starred in acclaimed artist Julien Nguyen's film *Spiritus Mundi*, in the role of US President Richard Nixon. He also created the soundtrack for the film which debuted at the Swiss Institute of Art in New York.

Parhizi is most recognized for his coining of the term and artistic genre of Imperfectionism, which his musical and visual artworks have been representative of since 2014. In July 2021 he curated a grand group exhibition titled "Salon de Imperfectionism" featuring 46 incredibly diverse artists.

The submission date has been EXTENDED to FEBRUARY 15.

The theme will be centered around California's species and landscapes "on the edge" of survival. It will highlight plant and animal species that are endangered, or threatened, or even extinct, and areas of land set aside for conservation & preservation of these species. We will be presenting this show with the purpose of bringing attention to their beauty and fragility, as well as promoting better protection and stewardship of our ecosystems. You may choose any natural spaces you

feel have been dedicated to the protection and preservation of nature, therefore landscapes will be considered for this show, as special lands are the very homes and habitats that permit our special species to exist and survive.

Artwork may depict a non-literal/invented landscape or be abstract, so long as there is still application to the focus of the show. We encourage all artists to utilize the "notes" section to describe not only the subject of the painting, but how it fits within this exhibition's focus on fragility, resilience, and the importance of nature preservation. Notes may or may not be used on the labels for the artist's piece, at the discretion of the Museum.

Also, note the size restriction is 30" wide
